

## COVID-19 POLICY

This policy has been put together with the aim to protect and prevent Coronavirus for all staff as well as students and their families while taking part in any Dance-Worx's classes. Below is a list of precautions we will take as well as what we will ask of anyone entering a Dance-Worx's class.

- 1) If anyone or anyone within your household is showing signs of Coronavirus you will NOT be able to attend any Dance-Worx's classes and will need to isolate for 10 days. Symptoms of Covid-19 include **high temperature, a new continuous cough & lose or change in sense of smell or taste**. - 2) We will reduce the use of floor work when possible.
- 3) All teachers will be asked to take a lateral flow test weekly.
- 4) Parents will be asked to drop their children off at the front of the venue's door and collect in the same manner, and should you wish to speak to a teacher please do so at the end of the class once everyone has left.
- 5) No parent will be allowed to enter the hall, should your child need help getting dressed this must be done before entering the hall.
- 6) Anyone entering our class will be asked to use the hand sanitizer provided as soon as they enter the school and when they leave, should you wish to bring your own sanitizer that's fine.
- 7) When entering the school hall your child will be given an allocated space to place their bags.
- 8) We will continue to communicate with parents/teachers & students following any rules put in place by the government.
- 9) Depending on the size of the hall class numbers of students will be reduced and 'bubbles' when advised to by the school.
- 10) Any cash/cheque payments and forms please give to the school office or dance teacher at the end of the session. Bank transfer is our preferred form of payment and we encourage everyone to do this when possible.
- 11) No drinks or clothes are to be shared with anyone else in the class, so please ensure your child comes to class fully prepared. No food is permitted in class, should your child wish to have a snack they must do so before class.
- 12) All teachers have taken and completed an online Prevent Covid 19 course with Virtual College, and will have a copy on them for you to see at all times.
- 13) Masks are allowed for pupils in class should you wish to wear them, however you will need to bring your own.
- 14) Our Policy will be reviewed regularly and changed to keep up to date with the government's guidelines.
- 15) All school clubs that take place in the school premises will have their own Covid policy which we will support and keep in regular contact to ensure all guidelines have been met.
- 16) Please note if we (DWX) cancel any classes we will, firstly aim to make up the session during the term, if this is not possible, we will issue a refund for the class.
- 17) If the school put any restrictions in place, we are unfortunately unable to offer a refund, however we will of course do our best to see if we can come up with some sort of solution to ensure your child has the 10 weeks paid for.
